

2009/2010 South African Survey

Key findings of living condition indicators reported in the 2009/2010 South African Survey regarding the Lejweleputswa district include the following;

- Total number of households are estimated at 200 038.
- The types of housing in the district comprise of 64.5 % formal housing, 23.7 % informal dwellings and 3.3 % traditional dwellings.
- Tenure status comprised of 51 % in the category “owned and fully paid off”, 7.1 % in the category “owned but not yet fully paid off”, 19.2 % in the category “rented”, 22.5 % in the category “occupied rent free” and 0.2 % falls in the category “other”.
- 97.4 % of households have access to piped water.
- 22.8 % of households still use the bucket system. The percentage of households using the bucket system decreased to 20 % in the 2001 Census.
- 87.9 % of households have access to electricity.
- 74.4 % of households have access to postal services.
- 66.2 % of households have access to cellular phones
- 77.1 % have access to radio and 64.3 % to television.
